

Tips For A Safer Campus Community

The cooperation and involvement of students, faculty and staff in a campus safety program is absolutely necessary. All members of the college community must assume responsibility for their personal safety and the security of their personal property by taking simple common sense precautions, for example:

- *Avoid lending your keys to anyone, even friends
- *Respond to fire alarms
- *Be alert and aware of your environment
- *Park and travel in well lit areas
- *Report suspicious activity to campus officials no matter how minor
- *Lock doors of vehicles, rooms and offices

Did you know?

Counseling and referral services for students are provided through several campus sources. In addition to each student's academic advisor, resources are available through the Student Services Office and the Vice President of Student Services.

Hazard Community and Technical College provides guidance and resources to help students deal with specific academic, career and transfer concerns. As necessary, referrals are made to psychologists, psychiatrists, social workers, and other professional resources in the Hazard Community and Technical College Service Area.

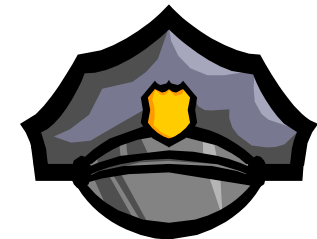

For Your Information...

Hazard Community and Technical College has prepared and published this safety brochure to comply with Title II, Public Law 101-542: "The Student Right-To-Know and Campus Security Act of 1990" as amended by Public Law 102-26, Higher Education Technical Amendments of 1991.

This brochure is a summary of a more detailed report. This report is on file in the Director of Student Life Services Office. It is available for inspection Monday - Friday, 8:30 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. and individual copies of the detailed report are available upon request.

We believe education and prevention contribute to our success in protecting members of the campus community.

Campus Safety Policies And Procedures

Students are limited to time spent in academic buildings after classes. The doors are locked after the last evening class. The library and computer labs are open until closing hours with an authorized attendant on duty.

Campus Safety representatives (Maintenance & Operations) enforce college regulations on campus. They have authority over all students, faculty, and staff in matters of security and safety.

All employees and students are expected to respond immediately to the direction of safety/security college personnel. Although we have qualified Campus Safety representatives and carefully designed security procedures, all members of the college community must share the responsibility of prevention jointly.

The college works closely with city, county and state law enforcement agencies who serve as the official police authority for the college.

Firearms

For reasons of safety and security on the campus, no one is allowed to possess or discharge firearms or explosives of any kind on campus at any time. Possession in one's vehicle of any of the objects referred to above will be considered possession on campus if the vehicle is parked on school property. Sanctions as permitted under the Code of Student Conduct and the Employee Manual will apply.
